### WHAT YOU CAN DO TO SHOW YOUR SUPPORT

**PARTICIPATE** in one of the public hearings on the FY 2022 Advertised Budget. They will be held electronically on Tuesday, April 13, at 4 pm; on Wednesday, April 14, at 3 pm; and on Thursday, April 15 at 3 pm. Check the County website, [www.fairfaxcounty.gov](http://www.fairfaxcounty.gov), for up-to-date information. **RECRUIT OTHERS TO PARTICIPATE.** It is especially effective to have users of services talk about them and how the services have helped them. Consider using video testimony that includes several speakers or a group of people who stand with a speaker to show their support.

**EMAIL OR PHONE** your supervisor and Chairman Jeff McKay. Because supervisors and their staff are often working remotely during the pandemic, email and other electronic communications are likely to be your best options.

**SEND** this package of information on to others who might be interested and concerned, and urge them to take action. Your friends, colleagues, neighbors, relatives, members of your congregation, members of the social action committee at your place of worship, members of organizations you belong to—all are potential advocates for human services.

The Board of Supervisors will act on the FY 2022 Budget at the special “Markup” meeting on April 27. That is when the Board will vote to amend the budget and then approve the final package—cuts, increases, tax rates, fee increases, etc. Formal approval will be on May 4, but, for advocates, the important date is April 27. Your advocacy for human services can have an impact even after the budget hearings.
